What is Shanty Town?

Shanty Town is a 3-day community event designed to raise awareness about homelessness in Adams County. Shanty Town is an organized effort by the Adams County Chapter of Habitat for Humanity to also do something about it — by raising funds through the event to build Habitat homes within Adams County.

This event will raise funds as business employees, church and youth groups, concerned citizens, and members of various civic organizations sleep overnight in their make-shift "cardboard homes". Pledges received will help to make the Habitat for Humanity dream a reality in Adams County.



Three-day community event... making the dream a reality!

Habitat for Humanity of Adams County ...

- Is a non-profit ecumenical Christian housing ministry
- Seeks to eliminate poverty housing and homelessness by building houses for qualified families
- Accomplishes mission through the use of volunteer labor and donations of money & materials

How it works:

A residential or commercial lot may be purchased at a cost of \$10 each. Up to four people can reside on each lot. Each participant must collect a minimum of \$30 in pledges (to stay overnight). A \$30 pledge will entitle the participant to a free Shanty Town tee shirt. Prizes, gift certificates, and all-day passes to Noah's Ark will be awarded to participants who collect \$200 or more in pledges. Visitors welcome until 11 pm.

Rules:

Shanties must be built **only** of cardboard, string, scrap plastic, newspaper and tape.

Time:

Registration begins at 1 pm on Fri and 8:30 am on Sat. Activities start at 4 pm on Fri. Shanties must be erected by 5 pm on Friday or 1 pm on Saturday. Shanties will remain in place until after the Awards Presentation on Sunday, May 20th and properly disposed of or recycled by 1 pm that day.
